

Tulip Block BVQG Exchange May 2019 (unfinished block 8 ½" x 16")

Tulip Top: Cut 2 4 ½" x 4 ½" color fabric

Cut 2 2 ½" x 2 ½" white background fabric

Tulip Bottom: Cut 1 4 ½" x 8 ½" color coordinating fabric

Cut 2 2" x 2" white background fabric

Leaves: Cut 2 5" x 5" green fabric

Cut 2 5" x 5" white background fabric

Stem: Cut 1 1" x 8" darker fabric

Assembly Directions

1. Tulip Top: Mark a diagonal line from corner to corner on each white square. Place in one corner of the colored print square and stitch down the diagonal line. Trim seam and press open. Sew two Tulip Top blocks together and press. (fig. 1)
2. Tulip Bottom: Mark a diagonal line from corner to corner on each white square. Place in bottom corners of the colored print rectangle and stitch down the diagonal lines. Trim seam and press open. (fig. 2)
3. Sew Tulip Bottom block to the joined Tulip Top block and press. (fig. 3)
4. Leaf: Mark a diagonal line from corner to corner on each white square. With right sides together, make pairs of the green and white squares. Sew ¼" along each side of the line. Cut along center line and press to make half square triangle blocks. Trim to 4 ¼" squares. (fig. 4)
5. Join 2 leaf blocks together to form a Left Leaf and Right Leaf and press. Join Left and Right Leaf blocks to stem and press. (fig.5)
6. Join Leaf and Stem Block to Tulip block and press. (fig. 6)

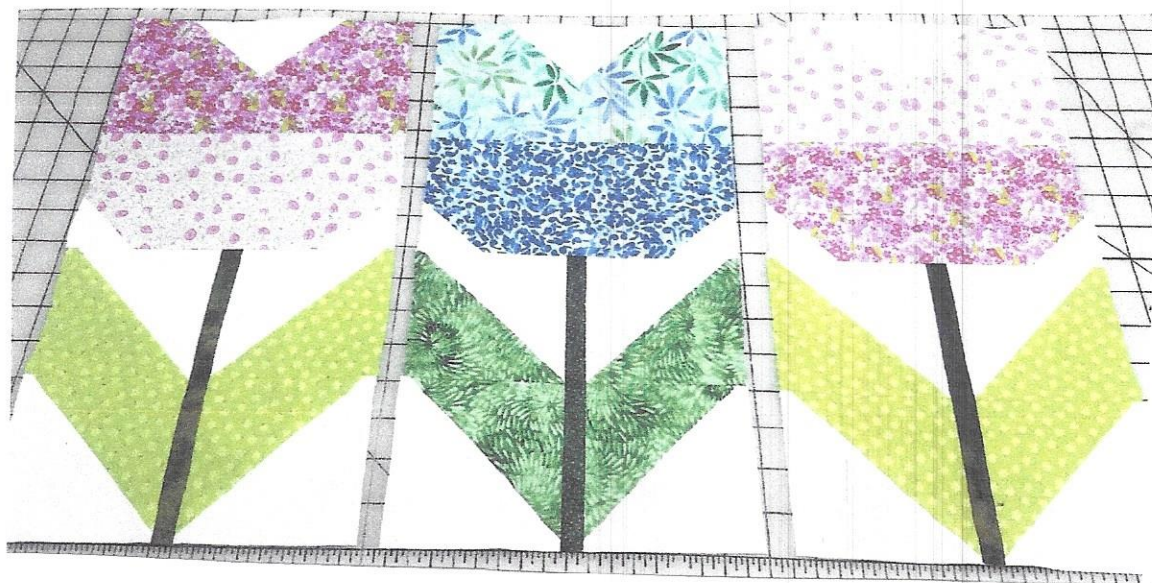

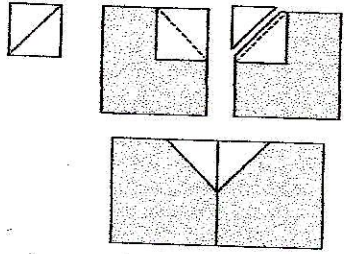

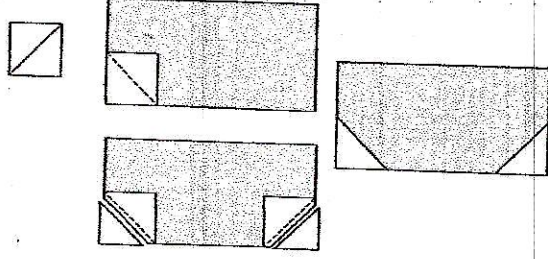

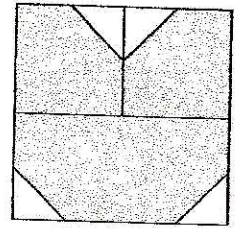

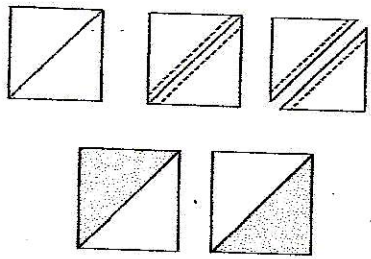

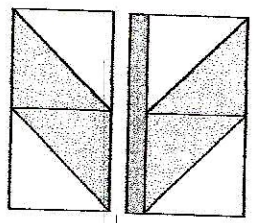
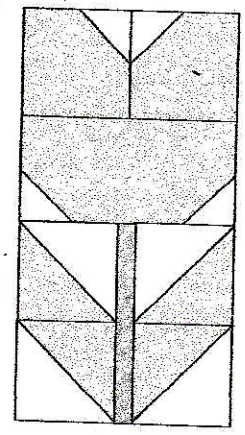
