

Maple Leaf Block BVQG Exchange November 2019

Unfinished 12 1/2" x 12 1/2"

Tan Background Fabric: Cut 2 squares 5 1/8" x 5 1/8"

Cut 1 square 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"

Cut 2 squares 4" x 4"

Fabric for Leaf: Cut 2 squares 5 1/8" x 5 1/8"

Cut 3 squares 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"

Green Fabric for Stem: Cut 1 square 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"

Directions:

1. Draw a diagonal line on wrong side of the 2 tan background 5 1/8" x 5 1/8" squares. Place each tan square on top of each leaf fabric 5 1/8" x 5 1/8" squares. Stitch seam 1/4" each side of drawn line. (Fig. 1)

2. Cut along drawn line. Press to make 2 triangle-squares. **TRIM** to 4 1/2" x 4 1/2". Make 4 triangle-squares. (Fig. 2)

3. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of 2 tan 4" x 4".

4. With right sides together, place 1 tan background 4" x 4" square on one corner of green 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" square and stitch diagonally on the line. (Fig. 3)

5. Trim 1/4" from stitching line. (Fig. 4)

6. Press seam allowance toward darker fabric. (Fig. 5)

7. Add the other tan background 4" x 4" square to the opposite corner. (Fig. 6)

8. Lay out block pieces and stitch together. (Fig. 7)

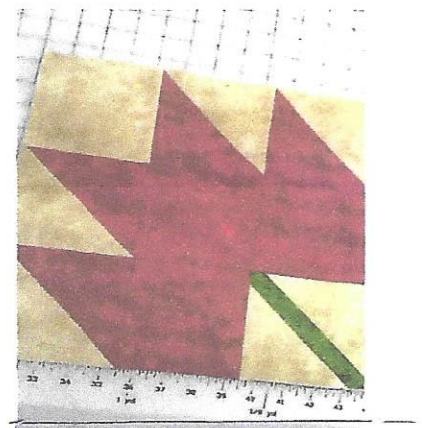
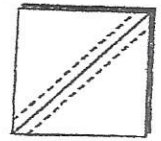

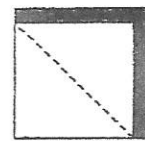

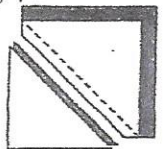

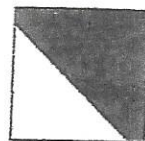

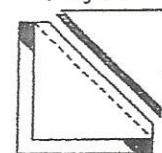
