12 1/2" x 12 1/2" unfinished

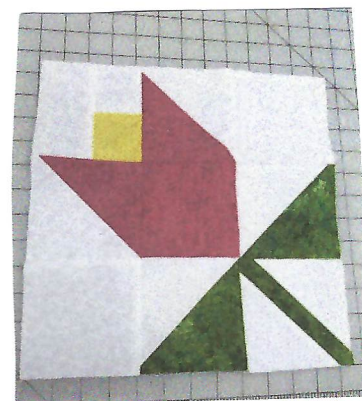
White Background: Cut 2 5 1/4" x 5 1/4"

Cut 2 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"

Cut 2 4" x 4"

Cut 1 2 1/2" x 4 1/2"

Cut 1 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"



Flower: Cut 1 5 1/4" x 5 1/4"

Cut 1 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"

Flower Center: Cut 1 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"

Green Stem/Leaves: Cut 1 5 1/4" x 5 1/4"

Cut 1 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"

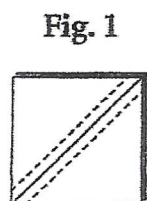

Directions:

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 2 white 5 1/4" x 5 1/4" squares.
2. Place 1 marked square on the flower 5 1/4" square. Place the other marked square on the green 5 1/4" square. Stitch seam 1/4" on each side of drawn line. (Fig. 1)
3. Cut along drawn line. Press to make triangle-squares. TRIM to 4 1/2" x 4 1/2". (Fig. 2)
4. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the white 4" x 4" squares.
5. With right sides together, place 1 white background 4" x 4" square on one corner of the green 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" square and stitch diagonally on the line. (Fig. 3)
6. Trim 1/4" from stitching line. (Fig. 4)
7. Press seam allowance towards darker fabric. (Fig. 5)
8. Add the other white background 4" x 4" square to the opposite corner. (Fig. 6) Sew, trim, press.
9. Sew the 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" flower center to the 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" white background square. Press. Sew this unit to the 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" white background. (Fig. 7)

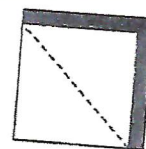

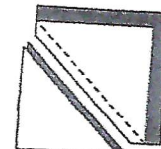

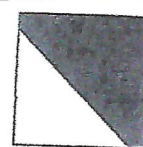

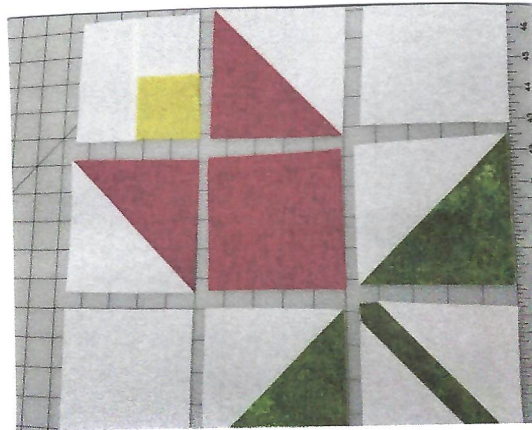
