

Acorn Block BVQG Exchange November 2020

6 1/2" x 6 1/2" unfinished

Black-ish Acorn Top: Cut 1 2 1/4" x 6 1/2"

Cut 1 1 1/4" x 1 1/4"

Acorn Body: Cut 1 4" x 4 1/2"

Tan-ish Background: Cut 4 1" x 1"

Cut 2 1 1/2" x 1 1/2"

Cut 2 1 1/2" x 4"

Cut 2 1 1/4" x 3 1/8"

Directions:

1. Draw a diagonal line on the back of the 1" squares.
2. Sew & flip the 1" squares on the black-ish acorn top 2 1/4" x 6 1/2" rectangle. Place a square in each corner; sew on the drawn line. Trim 1/4" from the line. Flip and press. (I press the seam open.) (Fig. 1)
3. Draw a diagonal line on the back of the 1 1/2" squares.
4. Sew & flip the squares on the bottom corners of the acorn body. Place a square on each bottom corner; sew on the drawn line. Trim 1/4" from the line. Flip and press. (I press the seam open.) (Fig. 2)
5. Sew the 1 1/4" x 3 1/8" rectangles on both sides of the 1 1/4" square. (Fig. 3)
6. Sew the 1 1/2" x 4" background rectangles to the acorn body. (Fig. 4)
7. Sew the rows together. (Fig. 5)

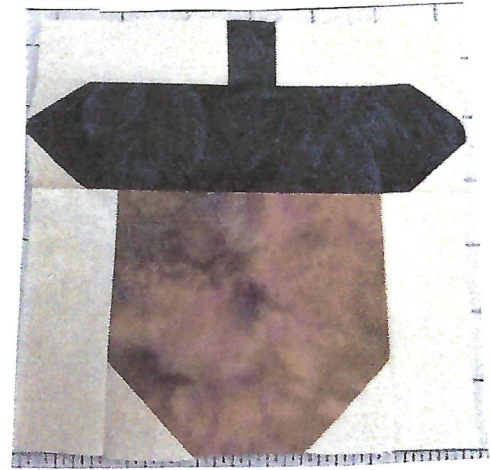

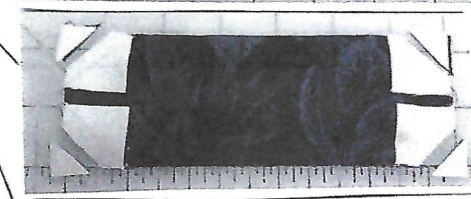

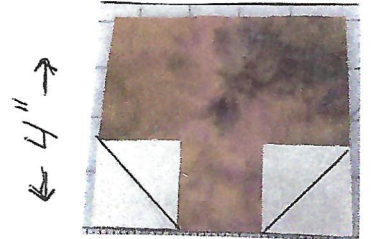

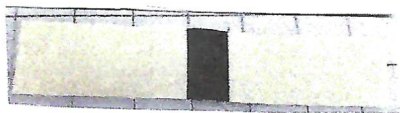

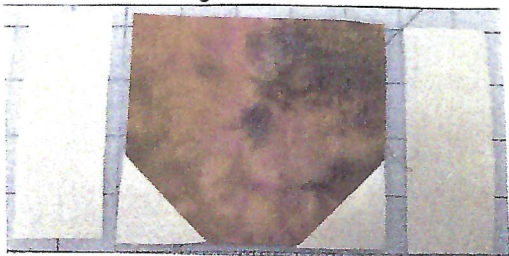
