

Dimensions for Charity Quilt Projects

Quilts

At this time quilts are being donated to Olathe Hospice House, Olathe Cancer Center, Safe Home, Overland Park regional Hospital, and Village Church Clothes Closet.

Keep these sizes in mind when making and donating a quilt:

- Crib 36" x 54", or a range of 36-45" x 45-54"
- Lap 45" x 45", or a range of 40-60" x 40-60"
- Throw/Napping 54" x 64", or a range of 50-60" x 64-76"
- Twin 70" x 90", or a range of 64-80" x 80-100"

NICU Project

1 1/4 yards of good quality flannel in two different prints. At least one should be light colored enough so the laundry marking show. Wash fabric in HOT water to shrink.

Using two layers of flannel, right sides together, cut 10 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangles

1. Stitch a 1/4" seam around the edges, right sides together, leaving an opening to turn
2. Trim the corners, turn right side out
3. Press flat, turning in the seam allowance at the opening
4. Stitch around very close to the edge. Back stitch your starts and stops, trim all thread tails
5. Stitch around a second time 1/4" from the first stitching
6. Stitch both diagonals
7. Give it a final press
